<p>MR Credit 5: Regional Materials</p> <p>Use building materials or products extracted, harvested or recovered, and manufactured within 500 miles of the project site for a minimum of 10% (1 point) or 20% (2 points) based on cost, of the total materials value.</p>	<p>Crosspoint wall covering products are manufactured in Dalton, Georgia.
