





## SOUND BLANKET CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS - ABSC/AQFA SERIES




1. Cut Panels with a utility knife or heavy duty shears to fit as snug as possible, keeping gaps to a minimum.



2. Compress the material at the edge of the cut out by placing a few staples around the perimeter of the cut.





- 3. Fold edge binding material over edges, equal amounts on front and back.
- 4. Staple edge binding material to panel using staples every 2-3 inches.






## SOUND BLANKET CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS - ABBC SERIES




 Cut through quilted fiberglass and barrier with a utility knife or heavy duty shears to fit as snug as possible, keeping gaps to a minimum.



2. Cut quilted fiberglass only back and additional inch from the outter edge of the cut barrier.



Edge Binding Material



- 3. Fold edge binding material over cut edge of quilted fiberglass, equal amounts on front and back.
- 4. Staple edge binding material to quilted fiberglass with staples every 2-3 inches so that the staples are not seen on the barrier side.
